Engage: Hook the students	Play the Read Aloud Book, <i>Pete the Cat Rocking in My School Shoes</i> , Created and Illustrated by: James Dean, Story By: Eric Litwin, Video By: Simitri Crane; https://youtu.be/BekNshW3iAQ?t=72 Introduce students to their classmates by using the Help Pete the Cat Find a Friend icebreaker activity. This activity gives students a chance to move around and get to know their new classmates. As students walk around the classroom, they find a "friend who," by asking their classmates questions that are on the sheet. The goal is to find a new friend for each box, the "new friend" should write their name in the box that applies to them.				
Explore: Students make sense of a concept through observations.	Students who struggle with reading can use the pictures for additional help. Students will complete the <i>Pete the Cat Rocking in My School Shoes</i> Story Analysis. Students will complete the Rocking with Pete the Cat Addition and Subtraction Review Worksheet.
