






	Explain to students that Patriot Day is a US holiday that honors and					
	remembers those who died as a result of terrorist attacks against the United					
	States on September 11, 2001, Patriot Day also pays tribute to the many					
	heroes who emerged to help those in need. On September 11, 2001, a group					
	of nineteen men crashed two airplanes into the Twin Towers in New York					
	and one into the Pentagon outside of Washington DC. The men tried to					
	crash a fourth plane into another building, but the passengers fought back					
	and the plane crashed into an empty field in Pennsylvania. The men were					
	part of a terrorist group called "al-Qaeda".					
	Many police officers, firefighters, and medics rushed into the Twin Towers					
	and the Pentagon to help those who were inside the buildings at the time of					
	the attacks. It was a very sad day for the United States, as many people died					
	or were injured. It was also a day when many people stepped up to help					
	people they did not even know, ordinary people did extraordinary things!
