



Engage: Hook the students	 Explain: Today's lesson is a part of celebrating Hispanic Heritage Month. In this lesson we will examine how we learn, share, and adapt to different cultures. One of the ways cultures are shared is through folktales. Folktales are a kind of story that gets passed on from generation to generation. True folktales do not have a single author. They develop as different people tell them over time. As such, they are creations of the people. Some American Folktales include Paul Bunyan and Big Foot. Create a Folktale Exercise: Arrange students in a big circle. Once the students are in a circle, explain that you will start the story at the beginning of the circle. Each student should create the next line of the tale, adding one detail. Allow all students to participate until the story gets to the last person. The story starter: "Once upon a time, I was walking in the woods, and I heard a terrible noise, I looked behind me and saw"
