


8. What did Kiara decide to do when she got a "C" in English? Kiara decided she would study harder.


9. When Kiara did not make the basketball team, what did she decide to do? Kiara decided she would practice harder and try again until she achieved her dream.

10. What lesson can we learn from Whitney and Kiara? Answers will vary but should include not giving up on a dream just because you may fail at first.

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

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


